Overdue School Fees

Growth Mindset - Building Positive Attitudes about Math.

Brain research shows that messages children receive from their parents about math and their parents' relationships with math can change their math learning and achievement. Regardless of your personal experiences, when you are interacting with your child it is important to keep the messages positive about math. When a child feels positively engaged and successful, they are more likely to persevere with an activity or with finding a solution to a problem. Through this, children learn that their brains can physically change with effort and it leads to increased motivation and achievement. One of the best ways to model a Growth Mindset with your child is to talk about positively about mistakes and struggles. It is important encourage your child that it is okay to make mistakes and to tell them that times of struggle are the most important times for our brains. When we are making mistakes, our brains grow the most - celebrate making mistakes with your children!

- Build a blanket fort







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


