New city bylaw coming Jan 2023 waste disposal program with blue and green bins in homes and businesses. Large Blue Bin to come for all recyclables as well as a Green Bin for organics. No logistic info currently, however the Division has put aside resources and a committee to advise schools. French Book fair week of October 17 in learning commons open for parents to come in and shop. Will be open Monday-Wednesday days and Thursday and Friday evenings for Parent Teacher Interviews.

Professional Learning Day October 13, no school for students. Teachers will be tuning behaviour support plans and learning about using technology for assessments. Division literacy teacher will visit to teach new resources for k-3 new curriculum.

Principal is working with teachers on their inquiry growth plans including learning and professional development goals for the year.

School fees are now available to pay online.

Agnes Davidson is excited to host a Christmas Market on November 19 from 10-4. We are still welcoming vendors, application can be found on school website.

Teachers are hoping to expand on council funding of Scientists in School program to include broader curriculum based learning activities.

Outdoor learning space is a goal of school administration. The gaga ball pit construction is still underway, and we are looking forward to a courtyard upgrade. Exploring costs to create an outdoor learning space that is sheltered from the wind and vandalism.

Initial data from a survey from last year's grade 4 families saw a decline in perception of Agnes Davidson as a safe and caring school. Parents in attendance suggest main causes could be related to both covid policy and the merging of two schools. Administration emphasizes the importance of self identity and self expression. There is a place for you and your family at Agnes Davidson. Parents are encouraged to reach out to teachers with specific questions and concerns.
