Not sure of how much we sold at the Christmas Market, but we still have quite a few bags left in the office. And if there is any additional ideas on how to make these items move does anyone on council want to buy some? For next year I don't think it's a good idea to sell at the Christmas Market, as we had to pay for all the bags up front. As Cuppers won't take them back after. As still the leftover bags is a lot this year we are out the money if we don't sell them. Shall I suggest that we take the bags into the office, and take them off the Cupper's order? But that was a lot of extra work. Not sure if it was the right path for Sue. I did want to wait for the council meeting to talk about this to get the orders in. Orders were supposed to be delivered this week. Thanks for the support and we can talk about the Spring campaign at next meeting. Selling at the Christmas Market wasn't as successful as we thought we did do 2- 10 bag orders to 2 different people. There were 4 or 5 bags additionally sold. There was a lot of interest in the coffee. A lot of people coming and asking about the coffee. There is a lot of decafs left in the office. There are some perked or granulated and some whole and mostly decaf that are left. So, should I make more posts on our Facebook page encourage stocking stuffers ideas? Do we talk about a quick reduction of sales or right at the end like at the last day grab a bag for this much quickly? And then also make sure that we say exact amount of cash only, because we don't carry cash in the office.
  - **Panago Pizza Nights:** We made \$750. There was a little bit of a mix up in the date. When Wade had sent the information, he wrote down 23/24 the assumption from everybody thought we were doing it on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and the 24<sup>th</sup>. We had meant 21/23. For March it was the same thing 26/24. So, we fixed it for March. In March we will only have the one evening instead of 2.
