A) **Principal Report**: (Terra Leggat)

- The grade 5's will be performing a musical performance and Mme Mahar Lee, Mme Bryant, Mme Low, M. Lyon's class will be showcasing some of their learning.
- We have a Spring Individual Photo Day on April 25<sup>th</sup>/2024. And we do like to photograph all students, because it is a fundraiser for us its \$2/head. So, we get about \$1000 or so for having them come in. But there is absolutely no obligation on parents' parts to buy from them you can if you want, but if you do you do and if you do not you do not, not a big deal.
- We just had a PL day on Monday April 8<sup>th</sup>/24. So, the teachers were with collaborative communities in the morning, so that means its sort of special interest to them, and they connect with different teachers within the Division so its kind of cool because we normally like we don't get to see other teachers in the Division and what people are doing in other schools. That just looks like Catherine Thorsen Vice Principal there reaching out to us and start to set up all the things that need to happen for a successful easy positive transition for our grade 5 students.
- Gilbert Paterson Band is coming tomorrow April 10<sup>th,</sup> and it just gives the kiddos a
  look at different instruments and things that they might and then it just keeps
  filling up that Band Program. They get to play them and some of our former

- I am just sharing that Green Shirt Day was today, it went well I was thinking like after the break no one would remember but there were a lot of kids in Green today.
- I'm just going through kind of like what Megan was saying it is Read-A-thon so today was Book Buddies Day I did see a lot of people like some people have book buddies already and some don't, so some classes paired up just for today, and that was kind of a special treat.
- Tomorrow is Dress Up like your Favorite Book Character Day so that is exciting like a mini-Halloween.
- Thursday is Read my Shirt Day, so just any shirt with writing on it.
- Friday will be nice, I know my students are mostly excited about Friday, cause its "Pajama Day."
- Some kind of insight for at least my classes some of the grade twos I am not sure where all your kiddos are in terms of grade level.
- The Assembly Mme. Low's class, Mme Mahar Lee's class, Mme Bryant's, M. Lyon, and Mme. Turmel class, we are going to be doing a kind of "Sport's" theme thing. There is a French song, like a France French song, about exercise and things like that. So, we are going to be having the kids doing a music video. My kids are really excited today, because I told them that they are allowed to bring in their sports gear, so I already know who is bringing in their soccer uniforms, whose bringing in their hockey stuff. I am going to bring in some Martial Arts stuff along with another one of my students, like it is going to be fun. We are practicing the song this week and filming next week. So that is going to be exciting that is

# D) District School Council: (JoAnn)

- District School Council had our meeting last night they talked a lot about the ASCA conference and just making sure that every school council knows about it and that the deadline is coming up April 15<sup>th</sup> have to have our registration in, if we are sending someone, and then also just be aware like how are we spending our grant money? Has it been spent already? Just making sure that all the school councils have that under control. There was some information shared about the budget. The budget is not great as we all know. And they talked about they now have on the Lethbridge 51 website a spot where you can review policies so every couple of months, they're putting in a few policies up on the website sending them emails to families in the division that they can go on an take a look at the policies that are up for review and add your comments to it so that's really cool.
- The Poverty Intervention Committee gave an update and an update about the Food Bank and that they are just sharing that obviously the needs have increased in the city. And there are more families that are using the Food Bank, and they are finding that it is more families that are working full time are accessing the food bank, which is quite sad, that its not just single parent families, its everyone.
- There was a question from another school council Immanuel Christian School they're looking at bringing in Kaylee Lowe who does a presentation on Technology and Technology Safety and So they're wondering if there's any school division or school councils that are wanting to cost share with them to bring Kaylee in and so that is something we can I guess that we can put on the agenda for one of our meetings that we can talk about that. Is that a parent type thing? Or is it for the schools? It would be more of a parent. Well, I think she does both. She will come in and do classroom presentations for the kids but then she is also willing to do like parent presentations educate us. If that is what to be aware of. She did some presentations like a couple of years ago too. I feel like she has been around the area for awhile. So, I want to see she did a presentation on the night we had our bingo a couple of years ago Oh yes because there was that.

# D) Alberta School Council Association:

• We do not have Donna here this evening. I do not think she said she is going to the AGM. We are still at the point of we need to extract what we can from information, we are going to do it. We did not really talk about this. We made our decision. We have not extracted the benefits yet of on their support. Like resources that we can access in the last little while. So, anything that supports the parents' community and school counsel is what the money is designated for. OK. So, we should brainstorm some things for how to spend the money, cause its April. I know we have always used like the I mean it has only been a couple of years that we have had that. We always used it for French classes, and they were the first year was the year I was Chair it was like it came like part way through the year and then you must spend it this year right. So, we dove into it. OK and that was the year we did not charge for French classes right as we had for free, and we were and that was a bust because people do not come when it started out strong right. The timing was also right with like spring activity and stuff too. I guess that we can put it on the agenda for next meeting to either come with ideas or brainstorm some things. We do not want that money to go to waste. Do you think that the ASCA website has like professional learning opportunities that you can explore to say like where council be interested in learning more about whatever topic I will just say fundraising I know that is not the only piece but it pops to my head of how to or how to go beyond fund raising but maybe there's something about recruitment.
